- 3D files must be in the .stl format.
- Items not picked up within 2 weeks will become property of Harrington Public Library.
- Harrington Public Library reserves the right to modify the model for successful printing (such as adding supports).
- Patrons must clean their own rafts and supports.
- Patrons agree to pay for 3D printed items based off of the printed weight (\$0.05/per gram).

Harrington Public Library's 3D printers may only be used for lawful purposes. The public will not be permitted to use the Harrington Public Library's 3D printers to create material that is:

- Prohibited by local, state, or federal law
- Unsafe, harmful, dangerous, or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others
